1. Casual News Editor / Reporter (Marathi)

Essential Qualification:

- Degree **OR** Post Graduate Diploma in Journalism with a duration of at least one year from a recognised University / Institution **OR** 5 year experience in reporting /editing work in print/electronic media.
- Proficiency in Marathi language.
- Knowledge of basic computer applications.
- Must have Marathi typing skill.

• Experience of journalistic work in Radio / TV (for Degree / Diploma holders in Journalism)

<u>Nature of Job</u>

• Preparation of news bulletins which involves editing of news and compilations.

2. Newsreader-cum-Translator (Marathi / Urdu)

Essential Qualification

- Graduate from a recognised University
- Proficiency in Marathi / Urdu Languages as applicable
- Having a voice of good quality suited to broadcasting
- Knowledge of basic computer applications
- Must have Marathi / Urdu typing skills.

Desirable Qualification

• Experience of journalistic work in Radio / TV

Nature of Job

• Translation from English to Marathi / Urdu and vice-versa and presenting the news bulletins and news-based programmes.

Method of Selection for News Editors / Reporters (Marathi)

The selection procedure comprises two stages (1) written test (2) interview. Each test carries 100 marks. The written test will be to assess the candidate's journalistic and professional capability, as well as knowledge of the language concerned Marathi. The minimum qualifying marks in the written test will be 50. Those qualifying in written test will be interviews to assess their overall personality and suitability for radio news by the Selection Committee. The selection Committee will recommend candidates securing 50 marks or above in the interview for approval for empanelment, which will be given by the **Head of Office of concern station for RNUs**.

Method of Selection for Newsreader-cum-translators (Marathi & Urdu)

The selection procedure comprises two stages (1) written test (2) voice test and interview to assess the professional competence and knowledge of the candidate in Hindi and English. Each test carries 100 marks. The written test will seek to assess a candidate's journalistic and professional capability, as well as knowledge of the language concerned Marathi and Urdu. The minimum qualifying marks in the written test will be 50. Candidates securing 50 marks and above in the written examination

will be called for Voice test to assess voice quality, modulation, diction, pronunciation and accent. Voice test may be followed by interview to assess the suitability of the candidate for radio news by a Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will recommend candidates securing 50 marks and above in the voice test & interview, for approval for empanelment, which will be given by the **Head of Office of concern station for RNUs**.

Written Test

The written test consists of descriptive type questions on general knowledge and current affairs, news drafting skills for radio, passages for translation from English to Marathi / Urdu and vice-versa etc.
